Part 1 – Cutting plans

The following drawings are meant to guide the cutting of the foam parts for the aircraft..


The materials chosen are EPS (styrofoam) for the main wing, to allow for the cutting of the wing profile, and XPS foam (the kind used for architectural maquettes) for the fuselage, for strength and lightness.he EPS should be min 3cm thick tto allow for the full profile cut.

The longest cut taken is \sim 30 cm, so the hot wire should be at least that long plus the thickness of the profile forms.





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
Main wing -1 side





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
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Page: 3 of 7 – wing profile detail


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



