The New York Islanders visit the New Jersey Devils at Prudential Center in Newark, N.J. on Sunday, January 24 (1/24/2021).

The game will air on MSG Plus, which is available to stream live on fuboTV and AT&T TV.

The Islanders have dropped just a single game this season, and are third in the newly formed East Division. They beat the Devils 4-1 at home on Thursday.

The Devils are 2-1 with 1 shootout loss to the Bruins that started their season. They are currently fifth in the East.

Varlamov IS human as he actually allowed a goal last time out against the Devils in Thursday's 4-1 home win. RW Nathan Bastian snuck one past Varly, snapping the goalie's 142:10 shutout streak to start the season. Not too shabby. He'll look to start a new streak on Sunday.

Wedgewood is expected to get the starting nod again, as G Aaron Dell is "in the process of joining the team," according to bench boss Lindy Ruff. Dell is needed with G Mackenzie Blackwood on the NHL's COVID-19 protocol list. The Devs are likely to lean upon Wedgewood heavily until Mac's return.
